### “Two Auburn Teens Arrested After Committing A Burglary In December 2008”

In December 2008 Auburn Police were dispatched to Sam’s Shoe Store at 20 E. Genesee Street on the report of a burglary to the business. The rear door to the business was forced open and an undisclosed amount of cash was stolen from inside the store.

Auburn Police Detectives Kyle Platt and Christopher McLoughlin worked diligently in order to chase down leads in the case and were eventually able to develop three possible suspects involved with the crime. On January 29<sup>th</sup>, 2009 the suspects were located and questioned by detectives and ultimately arrested for the burglary. Charged were Shawn Michael Parsons and Laeron Larnell Murray who were both arraigned in Auburn City Court and remanded to Cayuga County Jail on \$2,500 cash, \$5,000 bond. As of Saturday January 31<sup>st</sup>, 2009 Murray was still in the custody of the Cayuga County Jail and Parsons had been released after posting bail. The fourteen year old juvenile also involved with this burglary will be charged and petitioned through Cayuga County Family Court.
