

Justin Michael Tillmon was arrested for disorderly conduct. Tillmon was also charged with the City of Auburn municipal code violation for weapons carriage prohibited after he was found to be in possession of a folding knife. Additionally Tillmon was found in possession of an undisclosed amount of marihuana and powder cocaine which he was also charged with. Tillmon was held in the Auburn City Jail pending his arraignment in Auburn City Court.

Lastly, Auburn Police charged Eugene Watson with obstructing governmental administration 2nd and harassment 2nd after Watson attempted to intervene with the arrests of Deyquan Dale. Watson did push two police officers who were affecting the arrest on Dale. Watson was released after posting \$500.00 cash bail.

The Auburn Police Department has also filed a referral to the New York State Liquor Authority against the Polish Falcon Bowling Lanes. The New York State Liquor Authority is the overseeing authority of establishments licensed to sell alcoholic beverages.
