“Auburn Police Investigating a Domestic Related Homicide”

On March 6th, 2009 at approximately 7:18pm, Auburn Police Officers were dispatched to 35 Quill Ave Oak Creek Townhomes apartment complex on the report of a person being shot. Upon Officers arrival in the area of the U building, they located a female victim who was suffering from an apparent gun shot wound to her upper body. The victim was subsequently transported to Auburn Memorial Hospital where she was later pronounced dead. The victim has been identified as Lisa A. White, a 36 year old Auburn resident.

Auburn Police are currently looking to speak with Jerry L. White Sr., the estranged husband of the victim. Jerry White is described as a black male approximately 5’10”, 195lbs. Jerry L. White is described as having short black hair, a moustache with a scruffy type beard. Jerry L. White was last seen wearing a black zip up hoodie sweatshirt.

The Auburn Police Department is encouraging anyone with information concerning the whereabouts of Jerry L. White Sr. to contact Police at 315-253-3235 or lead investigator Kyle Platt at 315.255.4702. Jerry L. White should be considered armed and dangerous.
