### **“Auburn Police Are Requesting the Public’s Assistance”**

On Sunday March 15<sup>th</sup>, 2009 at approximately 5:40pm Auburn Police Officers were dispatched to Falcon Park at 130 N. Division Street on the report of a burglary. A passerby witnessed several individuals running to a vehicle parked in a nearby parking lot carrying baseball bats and other unknown items. The witness last saw the vehicle drive south on N. Division Street. It was later discovered that a forcible entry was made into more than one of the buildings on the Falcon Park Property.

The witness described the suspect vehicle as a dark blue possibly Chevrolet Impala. The vehicle was described as having front end damage and the driver’s side headlight was not functioning. The vehicle was also missing its front license plate.

There were possibly four suspects involved. The vehicles driver description is unknown. The front seat passenger is described as a white female with blonde or light colored hair. The rear driver’s side passenger is described as a white male, medium build with blonde or light colored hair. This suspect was seen running from the scene carrying several baseball bats. The rear passenger side suspect was seen fleeing the scene with unknown items in his hand and is described as a white male, shorter in height with a stocky build.
