“Auburn Man Arrested Following Weekend Stabbing”

On Saturday, May 9th 2009 at approximately 11:21pm, Auburn Police Officers were dispatched to the area of Arterial East near the N. Fulton St. intersection on the report of a possible stabbing. When patrol officers arrived they located a victim bleeding from a laceration to his hand. Further investigation revealed that a group of males were driving in a vehicle on N. Fulton St. when a verbal altercation ensued with a pedestrian walking in the area. The pedestrian walked up to the vehicle which had now stopped and began punching at the passengers through the window. During this assault one of the passengers suffered a laceration to his hand believed to be from a knife. The males in the car exited the vehicle and the pedestrian fled the area. Officers did locate the pedestrian involved in the altercation but the weapon used in the assault could not be located at this time.

The victim, a 22 year old Owasco man was treated at Auburn Memorial Hospital Emergency Room and released. Arrested following the assault was Frank Pilot Jr.. He was subsequently arraigned by Auburn City Court Judge Shamon and remanded to the Cayuga County Jail on \$10,000 cash / \$20,000 bond.
