### “Armed Robbery at State St. Kwik Fill”

Late Monday night June 29<sup>th</sup>, 2009 at approximately 11:29 pm Auburn Police Officers were dispatched to 134 State Street, the Kwik Fill gas and convenience store on the report of a robbery that had just occurred. Upon patrol officers arrival the store clerk reported that a white male had entered the store brandishing a large knife demanding the money in the register. The store clerk complied with the request and gave the suspect an undisclosed amount of cash to the suspect who was reported to be last seen fleeing on foot in a north east direction towards the Genesee Garden Apartments. The clerk was not injured during the robbery.

The clerk stated that the suspect had some type of black cloth covering his head and was described as being approximately 5’7”-5’8” tall about 150-170 lbs., thin build, light skin tone, wearing a black baggie short sleeve shirt and black basketball style shorts that were just over the knee in length. The shorts also appeared to have a white stripe with red trim on the outside lower leg area of the shorts. The suspect was also wearing white sneakers.

The Auburn Police Department is requesting the public’s help with identifying this suspect.
