“Request for Public’s Assistance Locating Wanted Sex Offender”

The Auburn Police Department is requesting the public’s assistance locating a wanted level 1 sex offender. The Auburn Police Department has secured an Auburn City Court felony warrant of arrest for Shawn W. Evans charging Evans with violating the New York State Sex Offender Registration Act. The warrant stems from Evans failing to verify his address with the New York State Sex Offender registry as required by New York State law.

Shawn W. Evans is described as a white male, D.O.B. 10-30-1980, 6’3” 180 lbs., brown hair and blue eyes. Evans was last known to be living at an Orchard St address but no longer resides there. Evans is also currently wanted by the Cayuga County Sheriff’s Office on a Cayuga County Family Court act violation.
