“Auburn Police Investigating Bank Robbery”

On Monday August 10th, 2009 at approximately 11:42am the Cayuga County E-911 Center received a phone call from an employee at Bank of America, 120 Genesee Street advising that an individual had just robbed the bank. Upon Auburn Police arrival it was learned that a white male approximately 5'4" tall wearing a dark blue baseball cap, gray t-shirt with a possible white shirt underneath the gray shirt, blue jean shorts, white socks, white sneakers and sun glasses had entered the bank and approached a teller station. The male handed the teller a note which demanded money. The teller complied and gave the male suspect an undisclosed amount of cash. The male then exited the bank and fled in an unknown direction of travel. It does not appear at this time that a weapon was used or threatened

At this point the investigation is ongoing and the Auburn Police Department is requesting anyone with information concerning this robbery or the identification of the suspect to contact the Auburn Police Department at 315-253-3235 or lead investigator Detective Douglas Parker at 315-255-4726.
