“Arrest Made for the Bank of America Robbery”

Auburn Police Detectives received a tip from a retired Auburn Police Officer who stated he felt he recognized the suspect shown in the bank surveillance pictures circulated in the local media following today’s Bank of America robbery. Acting on this tip, detectives furthered the investigation and ultimately located and arrested Edward F. Pelc for the robbery. Pelc was taken into custody without incident. Auburn Police did recover an undisclosed amount of money believed to be proceeds from the robbery.

Pelc will be processed and held at Auburn Police Department Headquarters pending his arraignment.
