“Auburn Police Looking For Missing 17 Year Old”

On Tuesday morning August 25th, 2009 the Auburn Police Department was dispatched to a complaint of a missing person. Upon arrival the officers were advised by the complainant that her 17 year old son had not returned home the previous night and this was uncommon for him.

Missing is **Nicholas M. Mosier**, a 17 year old white male described as 5'09" tall weighing approximately 135lbs with blonde hair and brown eyes. Nicholas was last seen wearing black work boots and possibly a blue "Auburn Double Days" baseball cap. Nicholas was also riding his gray mountain bike which has black handle bars. Further clothing descriptions were not known by Nicholas's mother at this time. Nicholas lives on Orchard St. with his mother.

Nicholas is mentally disabled but does care for himself on a day to day basis. His mother states that it is common for Nicholas to come and go during the day but he usually returns home by 9 or 10pm at night. Nicholas is known to frequent Seymour Library and Falcon Park in the City of Auburn. Police do not believe that there is foul play involved with his disappearance.
