### “Violent Domestic Leads to Arrest of Owasco Man”

On Friday June 5<sup>th</sup>, 2009 at approximately 8:00am, Auburn Police Officers were dispatched to a residence in the Orchard St. and Jefferson St. area for the report of a female being menaced with a knife. Upon patrol officers arrival the suspect had fled the scene and the victim, a sixteen year old female stated she and her ex-boyfriend were just involved in a violent domestic incident.

The victim states she had been awoken by her ex-boyfriend whom she has a child in common with. She stated that he unlawfully entered her home violating a full stay-away order of protection issued out of Auburn City Court. During the confrontation it is alleged that the suspect interfered with the victims attempt to call police by grabbing and throwing her cell phone. It is also alleged that the suspect attempted to push the victim out of an open second story bedroom window. The victim was able to break free but the physical domestic continued and at one point the suspect threatened to harm the victim with a knife he brought to the home. The victim suffered minor injuries during the struggle but declined medical treatment. The suspect was subsequently identified as Mathew Joseph Mallory who was arrested on June 9<sup>th</sup>, 2009 without incident. Mallory was arraigned by Auburn City Court Judge Michael McKeon and remanded to the Cayuga County Jail on \$20,000 cash bail / \$40,000 bond.
